

FELINE VACCINATION RECOMMENDATIONS

6-8 WEEKS OLD 1ST FVRCPC

9 WEEKS OLD (OR 3 WEEKS AFTER 1ST)

2ND FVRCPC

12 WEEKS OLD (OR 3 WEEKS AFTER 2ND)

3RD FVRCPC & 1 YR RABIES

THEN YEARLY BOOSTERS OF FVRCPC AND AFTER THE INITIAL 1 YEAR RABIES A 3 YEAR RABIES MAY BE GIVEN.

IF A CAT IS OVER 12 WEEKS OLD WHEN THEY START THEIR VACCINATIONS, AT LEAST 2 FVRCPC SHOULD BE GIVEN 3 WEEKS APART.

FVRCPC (FELINE VIRAL RHINOTRACHEITIS, CALICI, PANLEUKOPENIA AND CHLAMYDIA).

FELINE LEUKEMIA MAY BE GIVEN AT THE 9 AND 12 WEEK OLD TIMES BUT THIS IS ONLY RECOMMENDED FOR CATS THAT WILL BE OUTDOORS. ALSO, IT IS VERY IMPORTANT TO REALIZE THAT IF YOUR CAT IS ALREADY A CARRIER OF FELINE LEUKEMIA THAT THE VACCINE WILL DO NO GOOD. IF YOU ARE CONCERNED ABOUT THIS YOU SHOULD HAVE YOUR CAT BLOOD TESTED BY YOUR LOCAL VETERINARIAN BEFORE VACCINATING FOR LEUKEMIA.
